

- The professional quality of videos/photos should be ensured it is highly recommended to contract a professional agency to shoot the videos/photos (the agency can be also covered from O-RAN budget support)
- The videos/photos from each plugfest venue should be uploaded to the information about the storage place where to upload the video /photos will be provided later on please store all the videos/photos locally for now.
- The total length of all videos from one plugfest venue is limited to 30 minutes, and total number of photos from one plugfest venue is limited to 100. Please select and upload only the best photos and videos.
- The requirements on recorded video
  - MP4 latest codec
  - minimum resolution 1920x1080
  - tripod or gimbal stabilization for the camera
  - landscape (wide) format 16:9
  - neutral one-color background (optimal white)
  - · video must not start with black screen
  - every recording has to start with a clapboard including demo name, number (identification) and the name of plugfest location /venue (China, Europe, Japan, India, North America)
  - never start any talking/audio before 3 sec after starting the recording


