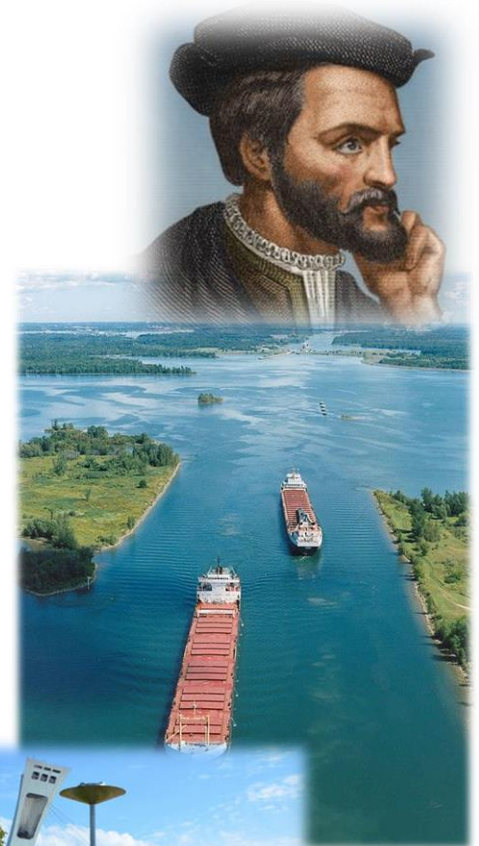

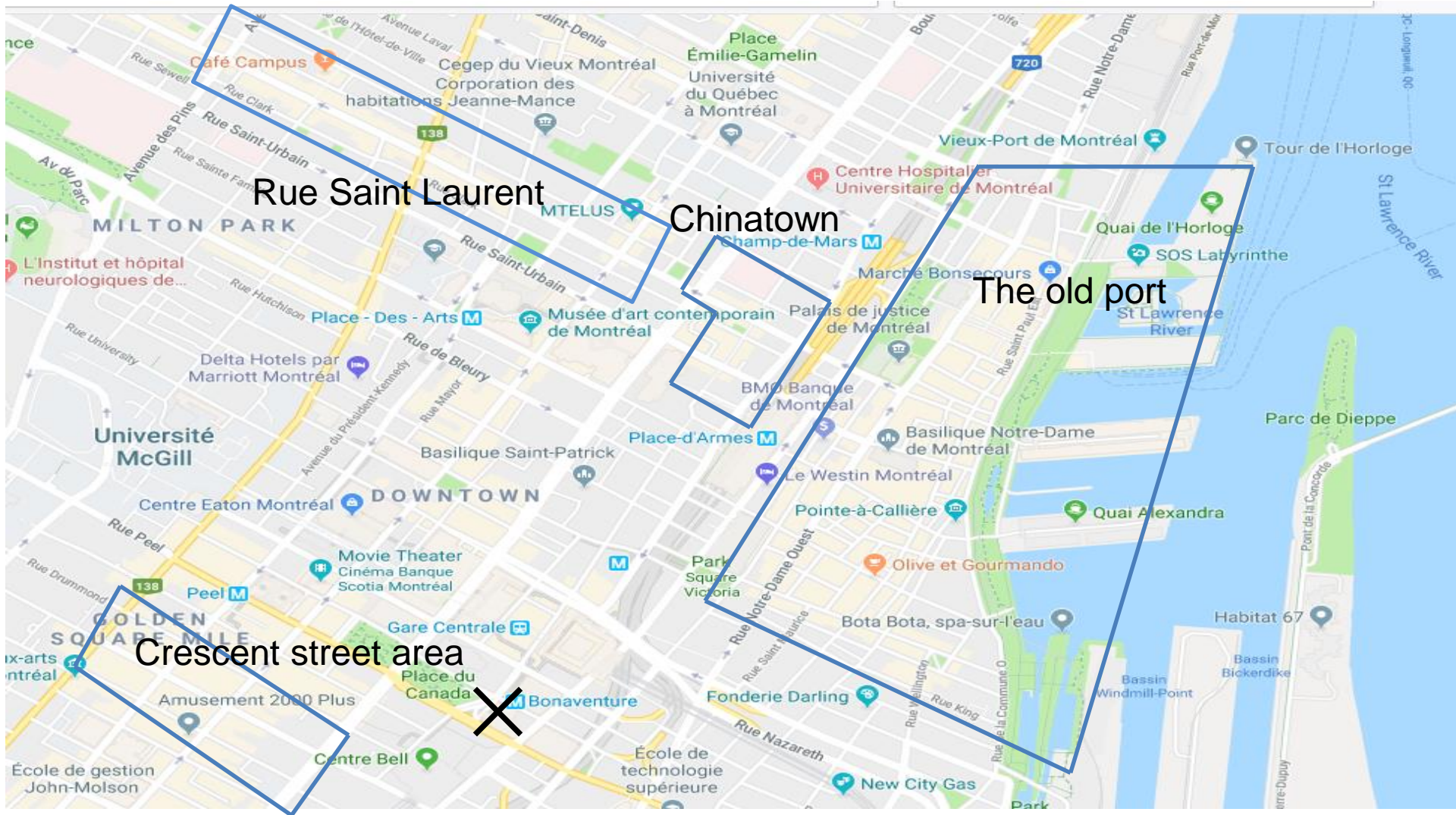


Brief Montréal timeline

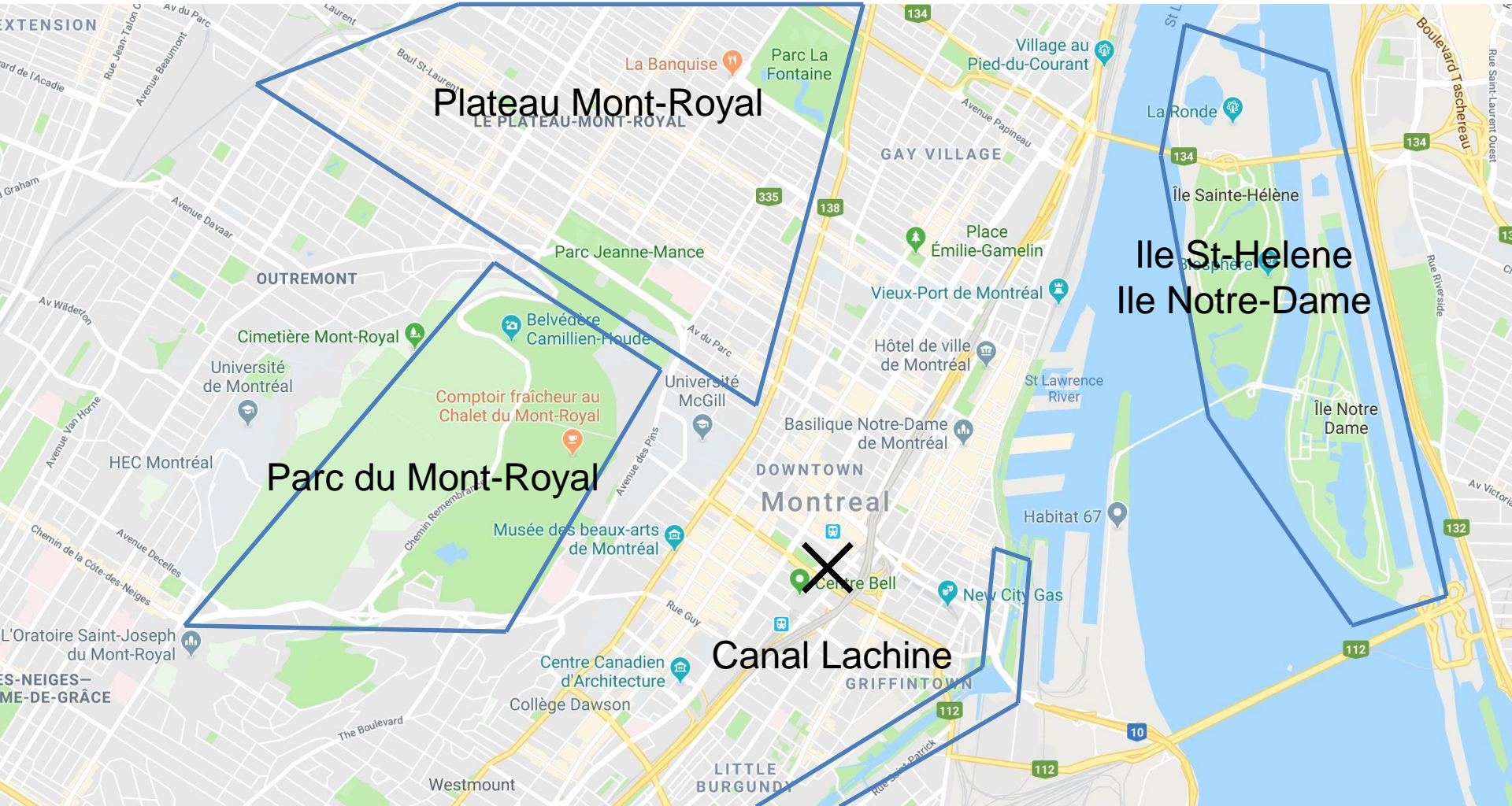
1535	Jacques Cartier discovers an island populated by Hurons called Hochelaga that he called “Mons realis”, “Mont royal” in Latin.
1642	Paul Chomedey de Maisonneuve with 50 French settlers founded Ville-Marie
1701	Great Peace of Montreal treaty is signed between the New France and 40 First Nations
1705	Ville-Marie is officially renamed Montréal
1760	Montréal surrenders to the British
1959	The Saint-Laurence Seaway is inaugurated
1960	“La révolution tranquille” begins
1967	Expo 67
1976	Montreal Olympics
