

Difference between a Product and Sprint Backlog

The Scrum Framework makes a clear distinction between the Product Backlog and the Sprint Backlog.

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The **Product Backlog** is defined as:

- The requirements
- A list of **all desired work on the release**
- Ideally expressed such that each item has value to the users or customers of the product
- Expressed as customer-oriented features (not as technical tasks !)
- Prioritized by the product owner
- Reprioritized at the start of each sprint

The **Sprint backlog** is defined as:

- Top Priority features from the Product Backlog that would be developed by the end of the **Sprint**
- Members volunteer to work on task
