Difference between a Product and Sprint Backlog

The Scrum Framework makes a clear distinction between the Product Backlog and the Sprint Backlog.

The Product Backlog is defined as:

- •The requirements
- •A list of all desired work on the release
- •Ideally expressed such that each item has value to the users or customers of the product
- •Expressed as customer-oriented features (not as technical tasks I)
- •Prioritized by the product owner
- •Reprioritized at the start of each sprint

The Sprint backlog is defined as:

- Top Priority features from the Product Backlog that would be developed by the end of the Sprint
- Members volunteer to work on task
