

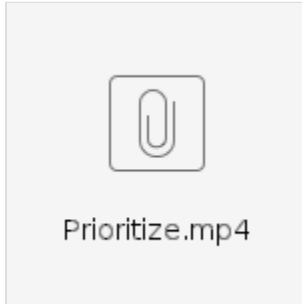
Prioritize a Backlog item

The Backlog items on the **top** of the Product Backlog are the Backlog items who are candidate for the next sprint (iteration).

As such **PTLs** need to provide **clear priority** (to **your** Team) and always move on the top of the Product Backlog the items for next sprint.

To prioritize your Product Backlog, simply select and hold a backlog item, and move it up or down (watch the 4 seconds video).



It is the **responsibility of the PTLs**, to always "**GROOM**" the Product Backlog. Meaning, have the top Product Backlog always prioritized and properly defined so the team can proceed with effective sprint planning.
