Jenkins -> Configuring Jenkins Job Failure Analyzer

Jenkins Build Failure Analyzer plugin analyzes the causes of failed builds and presents the causes on the build page.

It does this by using a knowledge base of build failure causes that is built up from scratch and kept up to date by the community using Jenkins.



- 4. Fill up the information (You can use a failed build's log as an example on what you would like the plugin to detect)
- Save your entry.
