

# Jenkins -> Configuring Jenkins Job Failure Analyzer

Jenkins Build Failure Analyzer plugin analyzes the causes of failed builds and presents the causes on the build page.

It does this by using a knowledge base of build failure causes that is built up from scratch and kept up to date by the community using Jenkins.

The plugin can be configured as follows:

1. Login into [jenkins.onap.org](https://jenkins.onap.org) (Only authenticated users will be able to create and update build failure causes)
2. Look for the **"Failure Cause Management"** link on the left side menu
3. Click on the **"Create new"** option
4. Fill up the information (You can use a failed build's log as an example on what you would like the plugin to detect)
5. Save your entry.
